Minutes of Meeting held on MONDAY 8<sup>th</sup> July 2013

1. To approve Minutes of 10<sup>th</sup> June 2013.  
Subject to a few minor alterations, Minutes were approved as a true record, and signed.
2. County Councillor
  - PH said that Wayne Fabian was going to be attending to give Councillors details on the Kiln Lane flooding update, Unfortunately WF phoned the Clerk to say that he was unwell and could not attend. It was suggested that when he was better, he would be able to arrange a site meeting to show the plans and what work needed to be done. Clerk will wait to hear from WF.
  - Junction Village Lane/Hedgerley Lane – PH said there is a new sign there, and time will tell whether the problem will improve or not.
  - The MVAS funding would seem that it will all be ok. PH will keep Clerk informed as to progress.
  - PH also mentioned the possible changes in Council Tax. He said he will keep us updated on this.
3. District Councillor
  - AC said she would pass on the various leaflets regarding children's sports available during the summer, including the UK Softball.
  - Garbage collection. This will not be in place until February. Food stuff will be every week; paper and card, and som glass, every other week. They will all be bins. Garden waste is going to be charged.
  - AC mentioned the Shia temple in Fulmer. At the moment are broadcasting a station once a week and the Imam has said that they are holding their prayers once a week.
